The Trophy is awarded to the church which in the opinion of the Trustees has achieved the best result (usually polled out of Committee in late Nov when totals have been analysed). Normally the sponsorship total is the key decider. *A church may not be awarded the trophy for a second or subsequent occasion until 5 years has elapsed.* The Trophy is held by the winning church for the year and returned to be engraved in time to be handed to the next winning church at the Party (usually in late Apr or early May)
